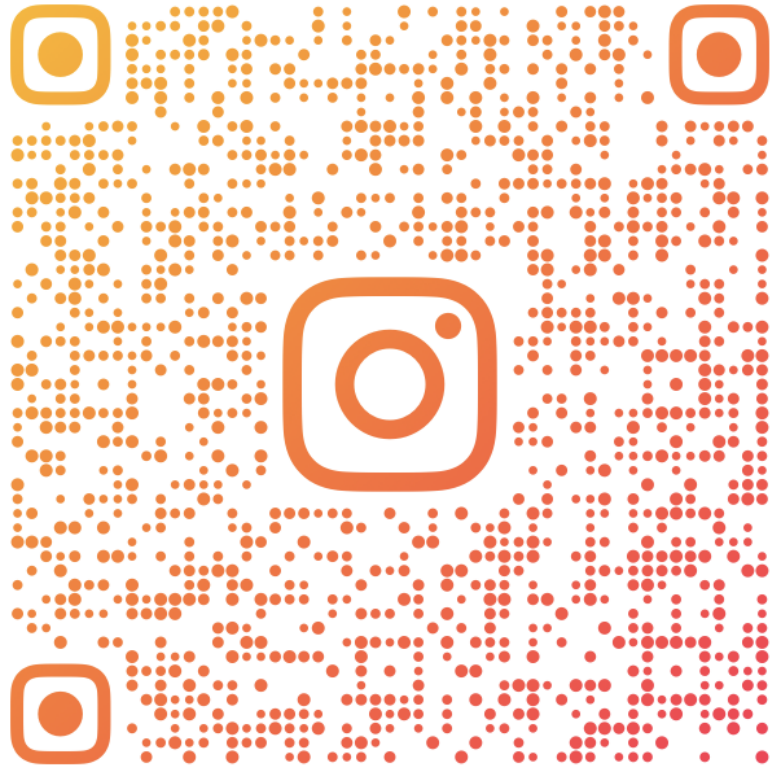

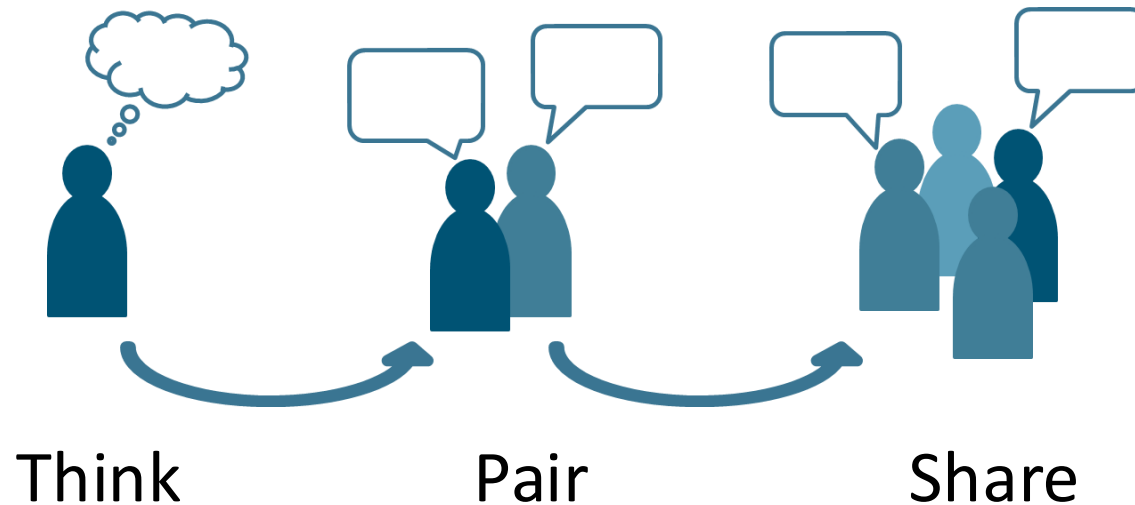

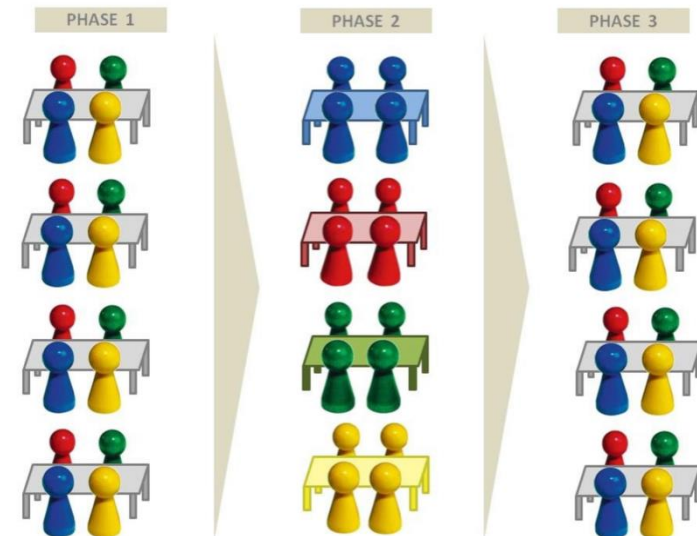
Sustainability and me

 - group puzzle



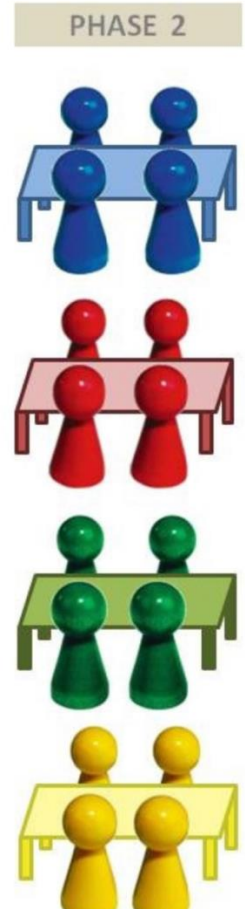
Phase 1 (ca. 20 mins.)

Phase 2 (ca. 20 mins.)

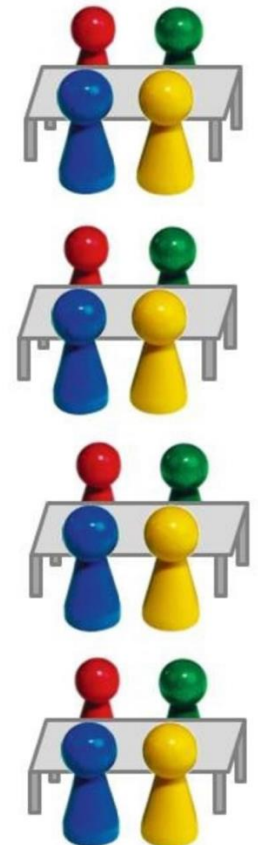
- get together in expert groups (all the students who have worked with the same text)

 - be finished by 12:30pm → we will present the videos in class!



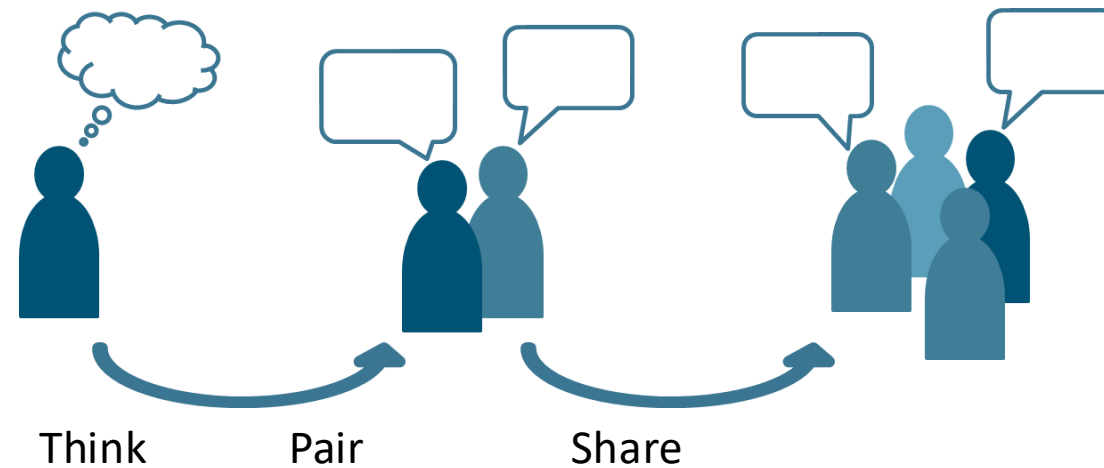
